December's Bible Trivia Answer:

Q. In John 20:2, John says "So she (Mary Magdalene) comes running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, *the one Jesus loved*, and said "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him".

Who do you think "the one Jesus loved" was?

A: Many believe that the disciple John was the one referred to in John 20:2. But nowhere in the bible is John specifically mentioned as the disciple Jesus loved. Only tradition names John as the beloved disciple, but he was never explicitly named. However; there is mention of Lazarus as the disciple whom Jesus loved. Consider John 11:3-5, "So the sisters sent word to Jesus, "Lord, the one you love is sick". When he heard this, Jesus said "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's son may be glorified through it". Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus".

So it is plausible to think that Lazarus was a disciple of Jesus because of Jesus' relationship with his sister Mary and Martha and the one Jesus loved. So, what do you think?
