For whoever has been born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world: our faith.

Read 2 Peter 3: 1-18

2 Peter 3:11-12 (KJV) asks “Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?”
